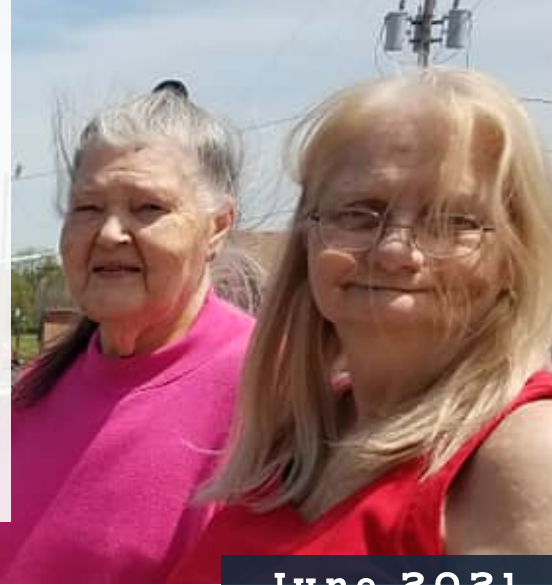

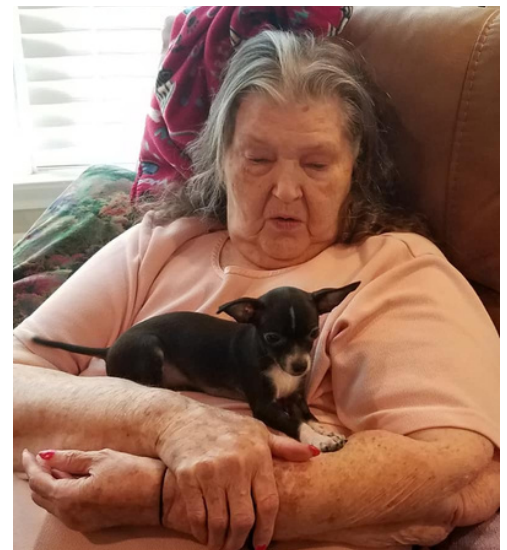

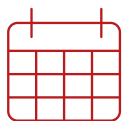

Loretta Herrin, 89 years, formerly of Fort Madison, Iowa died May 21, 2021, in Topeka, Kansas. She was born July 31, 1931, in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the daughter of Henry and Leona (Brown) Buehler. On April 19, 1952, she married Orville Lee Herrin in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. He preceded her in death on April 5, 1997.

She has been a resident of Fort Madison since 1974. She retired from Dial Corporation after 20 years of service.

She was a former member of the Harvest Bible Fellowship Church.
